MOVING FROM PRIMARY TO SECONDARY SCHOOL – SEPTEMBER 2021

This letter explains what you need to do to choose and apply for a secondary school place. Admission to a secondary school is not an automatic process and an application must be made by **18th December, 2020**.

The information you need is available through www.carmarthenshire.gov.wales/schooladmissions

This checklist may assist you:

- 1. Information for Parents booklet**
Gives you all the information you need to know before applying for a place
- 2. Research your secondary school**
Find your catchment area school/s online, visit the school website for a prospectus
- 3. Check transport eligibility** www.carmarthenshire.gov.uk/schooltransport
Read the transport policy and make an application
- 4. To apply for a school place outside of Carmarthenshire contact the Council in that area**
- 5. Apply online by 18th December 2020**
Late applications will only be dealt with after all applications received on-time have been processed
- 6. If you have applied already there is no need to re-apply.**

A decision email will be sent to the parent/guardian on the **National Offer Day which is 1st March, 2021**. No information will be given before this date.

Any parent/guardian who does not submit an online application by 18th December 2020, will reduce the chance of obtaining a place for your child in the school of choice.
