Enterprise Challenge	Coursework internally assessed and moderated	Spring 2021
Individual Project	Written extended coursework project	Spring 2021

Learners must complete the Individual Project and one other Challenge. Learner's final grade will be based on a judgement of evidence across the Components completed, taking account of adaptations made for 2021.

Other evidence that teachers have gathered throughout the year will be used to determine the Learner's Centre Determined Grade. In this subject the evidence that will be used is-

The National/Foundation Skills Challenge Certificate will gather evidence of candidate's understanding of and proficiency in four essential and employability skills: Critical Thinking and Problem Solving; Planning and Organisation; Creativity and Innovation and Personal Effectiveness.

- Community Challenge – Externally assessed coursework already submitted to WJEC, demonstrating candidate's understanding and proficiency in four essential and employability skills.

- Enterprise Challenge – Internally assessed and moderated coursework demonstrating ability in applying these skills

- Individual Project – The Individual Project provides candidates with opportunity to apply ALL assessed skills and demonstrate coverage of all four skills.
