How can I prepare?

- Revise language and grammar. Try out the exercises in this booklet. Take time to create your own rap or resource to remember rules for the future.
- Set aside a specified time each week to communicate with a group of friends through the medium of Welsh – text, snapchat, Instagram ... Make it fun. You don't have to be perfect grammatically, you just need to make a conscious effort to use Welsh.
- Watch the film Patagonia. Look at the background themes but more than anything take time to enjoy the film. Get to know the characters. You have two women taking journeys – one to find her past and the other to find her future.
- Watch some of the YouTube links and look at that “Linell Amser” to gain a better understanding of the history of Wales – it's struggles and success stories.
- Start to think about possible themes for unit 2, an area you would enjoy researching and working on.
- Aim to be an active part of that target of a million Welsh speakers by 2050, and to be part of our bilingual society.
