




How does your child join a class if they are missing a classroom?




On the Google classroom homepage in the top left hand corner there's 3 lines. If you select this it will show a drop down menu

The drop down menu will allow you and your child to see all their classes.


The key here is to select to do.








Private comments


Your child clicks into the assignment.

They can add directly from their google drive.


Add a link which includes websites/youtube


What is a Google Drive and why should your child use it?
