For some subjects, you will also have access to 'Advance Information,' to support your revision.

Your school or college will know all about the adaptations and Advance Information for your subjects – if you're unsure about anything, just ask your teacher and they'll let you know everything you need to know.

<b>History</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In the Unit 3 examination, narrow-timeframe questions will not be assessed</li> </ul>
<b>ICT</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Identified content for Unit 3 will not be assessed</li> <li>In Unit 4 we will remove the requirement for learners to complete the evaluation stage</li> </ul>

<b>Psychology</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In Section A of the Unit 3 examination, learners will be required to answer two questions rather than three questions.</li> </ul>
<b>Religious Studies</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Identified content (Theme 1) will not be assessed in the Unit 4 examination</li> <li>Identified content (Theme 4) will not be assessed in the Unit 5 examination</li> </ul>
<b>Sociology</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Advance notice of some aspects to be assessed in the Unit 3 examination</li> </ul>
<b>Welsh Language</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In Unit 5 the number of poems to be studied will be reduced from seven to six</li> <li>In Unit 6 the number of writing forms to be studied will be reduced from seven to five</li> </ul>
<b>Welsh Second Language</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In Unit 5 the period of study of the Welsh language in society will be reduced from the middle of the 20th century to the present day to the 1980s to the present day</li> <li>In Unit 6 the number of short stories to be studied will be reduced from four to three.</li> </ul>
