


Uniform

As part of a recent change to uniform policy, can I also remind parents and carers that pupils will be allowed to wear these shorts through to October Half Term. Please see below for full details. Should pupils choose to they can continue to wear trousers and skirts. Please note that sports shorts and lycra shorts are not permitted.
