### **Guidance Notes when making a referral**



#### The Grant is intended to support Carers of all ages, who:

- Live in Carmarthenshire
- Provides Care for an adult, or disabled child

## Carers can apply for Grants up to £500 to enable them to take a break from their Car

- The grant can include the cost of the person in receipt of care and/or a family member, partner, or f
- The break can be taken anywhere in the UK
- The Grant can cover the cost of transport e.g Taxi

## Examples of what the Grant can be used to purchase:

Vouchers towards a short break e.g., Hotel, Caravan, Cottage

As the referrer, we ask you ensure those who you feel as most in need at this time, those Carers who wou

If the Carer has already received a Grant via Carers Trust Crossroads from either the Respitality Grant or

Please ensure you make your case as to why you feel the Carers would benefit from this Grant.

## There will be several opportunities to apply for the Grant

The table below shows when the Grant is open to receive new applications and when it closes.

There is a week between the closing of one round and the opening of the next to enable us to ensure we carry out due diligence, to review and allocate resources fairly and equitably.

Referrers will be informed if the application has been successful once the review has been completed.

**Please note**, it is essential that all sections be completed in full, the more detailed the application the easier it is for the panel to make a fair assessment as part of the decision-making process.
